Dr. James Renihan

Dr. James Renihan is Dean and Professor of Historical Theology at The Institute of Reformed Baptist Studies at Westminster Seminary, California. He has written a definitive guide to church life among early English Baptists and is currently preparing his teaching material on the 1689 London Baptist Confession for publication.

Dr. Robert Oliver

Dr. Robert Oliver was pastor of the Old Baptist Church in Bradford-on-Avon, Wiltshire for many years, and has lectured in Church History at the London Theological Seminary. He is also the author of the "History of the English Calvinistic Baptists from John Gill to C.H. Spurgeon".

Dr. John Hall

Having trained as a GP, Dr. John Hall became an elder of Grace Church in Westerleigh in 1973, where he ministered for many years. He has written an invaluable booklet containing 12 studies that introduce young believers to Reformed Biblical Christianity titled "Christian Basics".

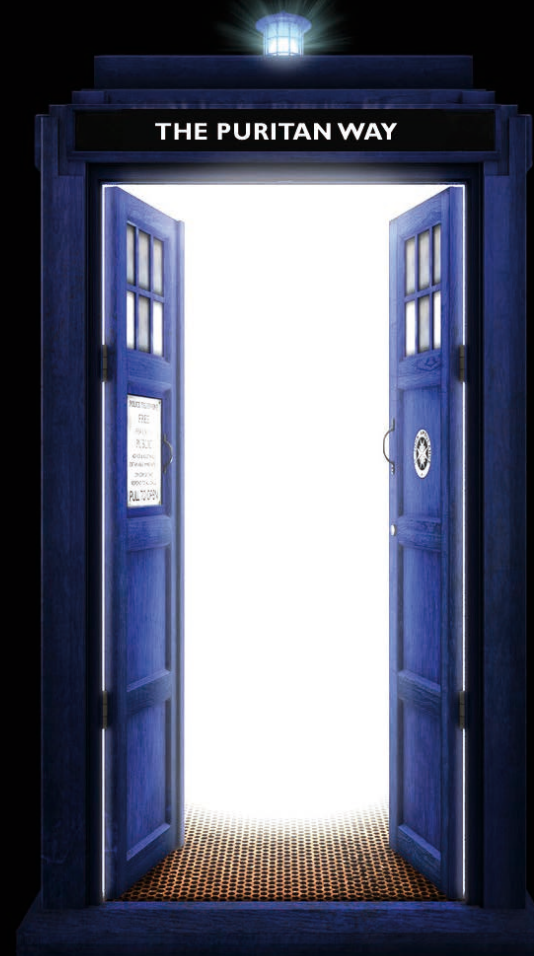
